

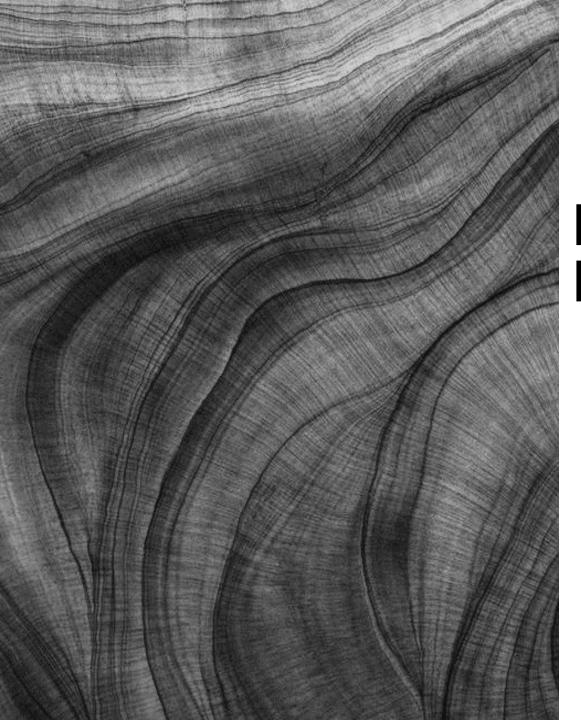

 Long-term funding, community ownership, and program growth.

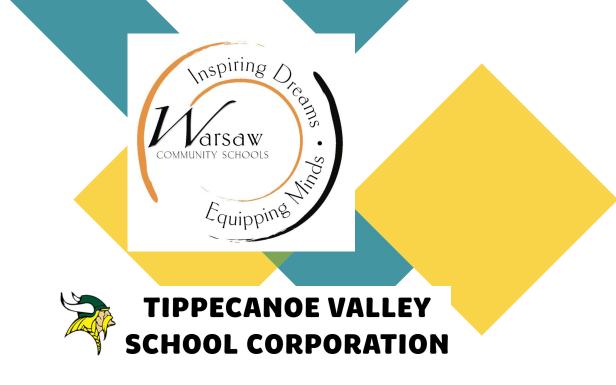


### **Current Operation**
