## Project Summary

**Project:** Design a program for High School seniors in Kosciusko County based on the Kosciusko

Leadership Academy Model

**Purpose:** Expose young adults who are potential future leaders in the county to the advantages

and benefits of Kosciusko County as a place to live, work, and build a future.

**Method:** Conduct periodic seminars for selected students at a central location. Presentations

would be taken from the KLA curriculum and made by the same persons or those of

like ability and stature in their respective fields.

**Scope:** Develope a written plan and coordinate with the fundamental parties to lay the

groundwork for future implementation.

Follow-up: Recommend implementation as a future KLA project with ongoing oversight by the

KLA Board of Directors.

The Kosciusko Future Leaders Academy is a program inspired by the Kosciusko Leadership Academy. The purpose of the program is to expand awareness amoung selected graduating seniors of the county's many positive and beneficial aspects. The desired result is that through the knowledge gained, the participants or someone with whom they interact will choose to become an active and contributing citizen here in the future. Initial contacts of high school administrators describing the program have been met with support.

It is presumed that students in the various high schools are as unaware of the trends and facts relative to Kosciusko County as were the participants in the Kosciusko Leadership Academy. Further, it is believed that exposure to this relevant body of knowledge will lead some to become leaders in the various communities of Kosciusko County.

It is realized that many of the participants will depart from the county after their graduation from school. Some will leave to further their educations and build their futures elsewhere. Others will seek employment and be drawn away from Kosciusko County. Some will remain here and start their careers. The Kosciusco Future Leaders Academy will help to assure that those selected will have an appreciation of what is available here. It is hoped that some of those who leave might return.

Whatever their futures hold, they will have insight into how communities function. They will gain perspective, know some questions to ask, and how to look for answers. Many will become leaders wherever they find themselves. Their leadership will be positive for their chosen communities and by extention to us all. The KLA Future Leaders role is to help provide a spark that might someday ignite a burning desire to become an involved citizen.
