EARCHING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

IMPORTANT POINTERS TO REMEMBER

- Listen to announcements each day at your high school and check your guidance bulletin board or scholarship information frequently for listings of scholarships and their deadlines.
- Read guidance handouts and mail sent to you by your high school during your senior year.
 Scholarship information may be included.
- "Zero in" on a couple of colleges/universities where you have been or most likely will be accepted. Write to the Department of Financial Aid at those colleges for information.
- Ask your parents to check with their employers to determine whether or not scholarship assistance for children of employees is available.
- Fraternal organizations to which you, your parents, or grandparents have membership often have scholarship programs. Write directly to their headquarters for information.
- Scholarships may be more prevalent from smaller, lesser known colleges and universities.
 Consider these schools if they meet your requirements for a quality educational institution.
- Academic scholarships are frequently granted for tuition at private or church-related colleges or universities with demonstration of superior academic achievement.
- Seek out college/university departmental scholarships. These are offered through departments such as: chemistry, physics, music, nursing, etc. Direct correspondence to the Chairman of the Department in which you plan to major, with a copy to the Admissions Office.
- If you are a talented athlete in one of the lesser known sports, and the colleges to which you apply are eligible to offer athletic grant funding, scholarships may be available through the athletic department even if you are not recruited. Write or call the athletic department.
- If you are interested in enlisting in the service following college, you may wish to inquire
 about a ROTC scholarship or possible appointment to a service academy.
- Read all information that comes with your admissions letter(s). Financial aid information
 may be included or may follow in a separate mailing. Most financial aid offers are made in
 the spring.

SEARCHING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS Continued

- Inquire about student loans. Your eligibility will be determined by the college or university you attend. The source of funding may be lending institutions such as: banks, credit unions, and savings and loan associations or direct from the federal government through the college or university.
- Credit by examination can produce the same financial results as scholarships/grants. Advanced Placement Tests, Achievement Tests, and CLEP subject examinations are just a few of the instruments used by colleges/universities for granting credit. Which instruments are used and how many credits you receive for scoring well on these exams depends on each educational institution. Inquire through the admissions office for information specific to the schools you are considering attending.
- Deadlines and awards for many scholarships are not until spring of your senior year. Patience and perseverance are the keys.
- If you would like to access a national database of over 200,000 scholarships, MI-CASHE is probably the best scholarship search for the money. It's administered by the State of Michigan for a fee of \$15.

Remember, it is your responsibility to seek out scholarship assistance. Ask, inquire, write, consider, listen, read, and then start over again.

CHOLARSHIP PROCESS

HELPFUL HINTS

- Obtain a copy of your high school transcript from the Guidance Office. Make sufficient copies of your transcript to accompany all scholarship applications you plan to submit. Only one copy of your transcript will be made without charge by the high school.
- Get the letter or letters of recommendation needed. Ask permission to make copies to use
 with other scholarship applications. Do not wait until the last minute to ask people to
 write these for you.
- Be sure to have plenty of current billfold size photos to include with applications when requested.
- Start looking for scholarship and loan information during your sophomore and junior years
 of high school. Parents need to complete tax information as soon a possible in order to
 meet application deadlines.
- Fill in all the application information requested. Use non applicable when information requested does not apply. Incomplete applications are usually not considered.
- Your public library is an excellent source of information on state and private sources of aid. Your financial need is usually considered, but other factors may also be taken into account.
- Many companies, as well as labor unions, have programs to help pay the cost of post secondary education for employees or members (or for their children).
- Check foundations, religious organizations, fraternities or sororities, and town or city
 clubs. Include community organizations and civic groups such as the American Legion,
 YMCA, 4-H Clubs, Kiwanis, Jaycees, Chamber of Commerce, and the Girl or boy Scouts.
- National Honor Society and National Merit scholarships are available if you have high grades and you qualify.
- Don't overlook aid from organizations connected with your field of interest.
- Type or print legibly. Applications may be disregarded if illegible

CHOLARSHIP INTERVIEWS

THE DO'S AND DON'TS

DO:

- Be punctual. Check the interview location before leaving home.
- Dress appropriately, as if applying for a job.
- Be prepared to discuss your financial situation, college and career goals.
- Listen to the interview questions carefully; think about what you will say before replying.
- Be brief and honest with your answers, but give complete responses.
- Have questions ready to ask the interviewer(s).
- Maintain good eye contact and a speaking voice that can be easily heard.
- Demonstrate interest, confidence, & enthusiasm, and remember to smile.
- If you shake hands with the interviewer(s), use a firm handshake.
- Thank the interviewer for his/her time and consideration.

DON'T:

- Assume the interviewer is knowledgeable about you and your background. Politely
 provide all pertinent information about your scholastic history, future goals, and
 aspirations.
- Be negative or critical about teachers, school, or friends.
- Be afraid to say "I don't know" or ask a question at the appropriate time.
- Indulge in any nervous habits.
- Expect the interviewer to make a decision on the day of the interview.

CHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

SUGGESTIONS FOR COMPLETION

- Remember! Your scholarship application represents YOU.
- Give your application the time, attention, and preparation that you and it deserve.
- Read and follow the instructions carefully.
- Type or print neatly.
- Proofread your work--especially your essay--if one is requested. Check the spelling.
 Check the grammar. You may even wish to ask a friend/teacher to proofread your completed application.
- Be honest and be yourself.
- If you are asked to talk about yourself, don't be afraid to highlight your strengths. Be truthful without being boastful.
- Make certain the persons you ask to prepare letters of recommendation know you well.
- Watch deadlines financial aid offices and scholarship personnel adhere to them!
- Remember, you are responsible for making sure that all parts of the application arrive on time. If letters of recommendation or transcripts are required, give the persons who will provide these generous lead time. Also give them a stamped, addressed envelope if the recommendation is to be mailed separately.
- Make a copy of the application for your file.
- Finally keep a written record of scholarships for which you applied. Make a note of the deadlines, requirements, and responses.
- Answer all correspondence promptly. Failure to meet a deadline may eliminate you from consideration.

DESCRIPTION OF SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship provided financial aid to any person seeking to improve their education by attending any properly accredited or certified education program. The scholarship is made by a scholarship committee according to the needs of the individual applicant. The scholarship may be used for college, vocational school, rehabilitation training, or any properly accredited course.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Applicants must be a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana, at the time of their graduation from high school.
- B. For college bound applicants, SAT, ACT, PSAT, or equivalent scores will be required; no specific rank in class required.
- C. Those applying for assistance to continue a course in which they are already enrolled must submit transcript of grades and present status from institution or program which they are attending.
- D. Those entering vocational, rehabilitation or any other type of training must present to the committee sufficient evidence of skills and ability to pursue such a course of study.
- E. Applicants may reapply for continuance of this scholarship.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- A. The Application will be available at the offices of the counselors of area high schools where Kosciusko County residents are in attendance and the Trust Department of the Lake City Bank, Warsaw, Indiana.
- B. The applicant must submit a packet consisting of:
 - 1. Completed application.
 - 2. Transcript of grades from their high school.
 - Three letters of recommendation; one from a teacher from a department in which you have a major, and two non-school references.
 - 4. If awarded the scholarship the previous year, no picture or letters required.

All completed application packets must be submitted to the Lake City Bank Trust Department on or before April 1. Late applications will be refused.

Because of this, the Breakfast Optimist Club of Warsaw, Indiana, Inc. has established the scholarship trust. The purpose of the trust is to grant awards to students who are *Warsaw Community High School* graduates and wish to further their education. The recipient must demonstrate through their academic record at Warsaw Community High School the ability to satisfactorily complete their chosen course of study.

The recipient shall not be a dependent or child of a member of the Breakfast Optimist Club of Warsaw, Indiana, Inc.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Applicant must be a resident of Kosciusko County, Indiana, and must have graduated from <u>Warsaw Community High School</u>.
- 2. The applicant must show evidence of financial need and a scholastic record indicative of a successful college career.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Applicant shall complete a scholarship application available either from a high school principal, guidance director, or the Trust Department, First National Bank of Warsaw.
- 2. Applicant shall submit a transcript of high school or college credits.
- 3. Applicant shall submit a current photo of himself/herself.
- 4. Applicant shall submit a financial aid form or first page from parents' current Federal Income Tax Return.
- 5. Applicant shall submit <u>three</u> letters of recommendation; two letters from current or past teachers and one from a person of your choice.
- 6. All materials <u>must</u> be delivered to the Trust Department, First National Bank of Warsaw, on or before *April 1*.

Reapplications:

If you received this scholarship last year, you may reapply by sending a letter setting forth your desire to be considered again. You must also send a copy of your most recent college grades. If you have previously applied but *did not* receive a scholarship, you must complete the entire "Application Process."

After April 1, a Scholarship Committee (not less than three and not more than five members) appointed by the President of the Breakfast Optimist Club of Warsaw, Indiana, Inc. will select the recipeints. Awards will be paid to the educational institution after acceptance and must be used for tuition, books, fees or room and board.



ANGUE MCDONALD

The youth of this area are indeed fortunate that Angus C. McDonald, a young Scottish doctor, chose Warsaw as his home. Although no one realized it, the first step had been taken toward the creation of a memorial trust fund to assist worthy, needy students, residing in Kosciusko County, to acquire a college education.

Dr. McDonald was born on Prince Edward Island in Canada. After graduating from the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine in 1892, he came to Warsaw. During a long career in this community, he acquired a reputation not only as an outstanding physician but also as a citizen keenly interested in the civic welfare of his adopted community.

Dr. McDonald's vision and ability enriched and improved the Warsaw community during his lifetime and after his death. Dr. McDonald established the first hospital in Warsaw, and was the first Warsaw physician to acquire an automobile to use in his profession. He was one of the founders, and the first president, of the Baker Boys' Club, a local boys' organization which continues to be strong and active.

The Memorial Fund, created by Dr. Angus C. McDonald, was established to enable worthy and needy Kosciusko County students to obtain a college or professional education. Students applying for loans must be enrolled and in good standing or have been accepted for enrollment at an eligible school. Most public and private institutions meet the eligibility requirements.

Selection Criteria

In determining the recipients of these loans, the Superintendent of the Warsaw Community Schools will consider prior academic performance, recommendations regarding the applicant's capabilities and character and a personal interview to determine the motivation of the potential recipient.

Interest Costs

Loans are interest free while the recipient is in school and four months thereafter. However, all loans are interest-bearing during the repayment period.

Repayment Filod

Repayment begins five months after the recipient completes his course of study or leaves school, and is normally scheduled from five to ten years. Minimum monthly payments are \$50.

Prepayment

Recipients are urged and encouraged to repay loans as soon as possible. If loans are paid during grace period, recipient will incur no interest charge.

Deferment of Principal Repayments

Deferments of principal repayments are allowed up to three years for military service. Payment may also be deferred during any period that the student returns to school on a full time basis. The student is encouraged, however, to make payments during such periods.

Where to Apply

Applications for all loans are made to the Superintendent of the Warsaw Community Schools, Warsaw, Indiana.

Fill in all the application information requested Use non applicable when information requested does not apply Incomplete applications are usually not considered

Your public library is an excellent source of information on state and private sources of aid. Your financial need is usually considered, but other factors may also be taken into account
